What is the new Normal?

We are still facing ongoing challenges within the practice and managing a higher level of ongoing patient demand. We are continuing to work tirelessly to provide a great service to all our patients. Our Rota is a moving feast and we are proactively reviewing our ways of working as we return to the New Normal.

Some helpful information:

- 42% of patients had multiple appointments (more than one in the month) – Please think do I really need that appointment, or can I manage things differently?
- 45 patients simply did not turn up = over 11 hours of wasted clinic time

Travel Vaccines

We are now able to offer travel vaccines to our patients. If you are travelling abroad it is essential that you book your appointment with the travel nurse well in advance of your departure date – about 6-8 weeks before you travel is ideal. We cannot guarantee appointment availability.
